SPD's Charity Hongbao is an annual fundraising initiative designed to provide members of the public an opportunity to play a part in improving the lives of people with disabilities and bringing about a brighter and more inclusive tomorrow.

We encourage participating companies to engage your employees and business partners/customers, inspiring them to partake in the spirit of giving during the festive season. By doing so, it creates a ripple effect, providing an opportunity for everyone to make a meaningful difference in the lives of those with disabilities. Together, we can instil empathy, kindness and a sense of community, shaping a brighter future for all.

MECHANICS

Participating companies will be given Hongbao packets for their staff's contributions. All are encouraged to:

- Insert their contributions into the Hongbao packet.
- Drop them into the collection boxes provided by SPD.

Donations can also be made online by scanning the QR code at the back of the Hongbao packets. All donations will enjoy 2.5 times tax deduction and 40% matching grants from Tote Board's Enhanced Fund-Raising Programme.

- To provide employees with a better understanding of people with disabilities and ways which they can make a difference in their lives, fostering a more inclusive society.

ABOUT SPD

SPD is a local charity set up to help people with disabilities or who may develop disabling conditions of all ages to maximise their potential and integrate them into mainstream society.

Through over 20 programmes and services that encompass early intervention, therapy, vocational training, assistive technology, day care, as well as educational, employment and social service support, we serve people with physical, sensory and developmental needs.

In 2024, SPD received another three years' accreditation for Enabling Mark Gold. The Enabling Mark is a national accreditation framework by SG Enable that benchmarks and recognises organisations for best practices and outcomes in disability-inclusive employment.

SPD's commitment to excellent governance was recognised with the Charity Transparency Award 2024, presented by the Charity Council. This award marks the seventh consecutive win for SPD since 2016, highlighting the robust practices and transparency we prioritise in serving our community.

SPD was conferred the Charity Transparency Award in 2023 for the sixth consecutive year since the Charity Council introduced it in 2016 to encourage good governance and disclosure practices amongst organisations in the charity sector.
